Origin of this calibre

The calibre .222 Rem. is very popular as all-round calibre for hunting and sport shooting. It is both used for bench rest shooting and for hunting lighter game.

This calibre is very suitable for hunting roe deer and fox, whereas roe deer can surely be killed up to a distance of 200 m. Furthermore, this calibre is usable for shooting hare from a high seat as well as wood grouse and black grouse, because the small calibre causes very little damage to the game's meat.

The development was already in 1950 and back then was a new development from Remington. Its constructive advantages still matter today: Low recoil and high precision.

CAUTION: This cartridge is not recommended for the hunting use.



Hunting Match MJ

This projectile is especially in demand when hunters participate in competitions and young hunter training and tests are underway. The Tombak jacket ensures low passage friction of the projectile and therefore reduces barrel strain. Small but important modifications in detail bring out all the precision of your weapon, ignoring target ballistics. The 3.4 g projectile has been continually developed specifically for training towards huntsman exams. Due to its compliance with Federal hunting law (E 100 >1000 J), the RWS .222 Rem MJ 3.4 g projectile is particularly suitable for huntsman training and the actual shooting examination. Not suitable for hunting.
