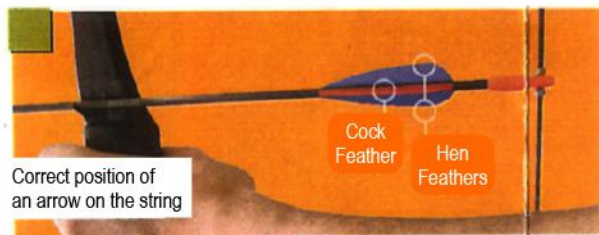
Safety

Before Use:

- Always check the condition of your bow, your string and your arrows; never use a bow or arrows that have signs of wear and tear, such as cracks or breaks.
- Ensure that the cord is properly seated in the bow nocks and string grooves.
- Always wear an arm guard.
- Place the arrow on the correct side, on the left of the bow for right-handed, on the right side for left-handed.
- Check the positioning of the Cock feather.
- Ensure that the arrow length is suitable to your size.

After Archery:

- Remove the string from your bow.
- Never leave your bow in the heat. (for example: in the boot of your car, or in the sun.)

Kit Contents:

- ▶ One Rolan Snake bow
- ▶ One bow string
- ▶ Two string nocks
- ▶ Four Arrow rests
- ▶ (two right, two left)
- ▶ One arm guard
- ▶ Three Arrows

IMPORTANT

Never release the string without an arrow, it may damage your bow and cause injury.

Never release an arrow vertically, or at people, animals, roads or housing.

This bow is not a toy, and children must always be under the supervision of a proficient adult.

Quick Guide

Rolan Snake

Preparation

This bow doesn't need a bow stringer, as the composite structure of the bow makes it quite flexible.

Proceed as follows to set up your bow.



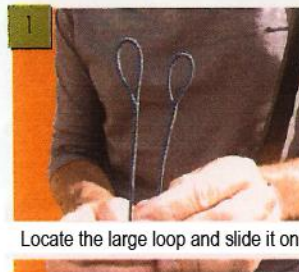
Your bow is ready to be strung.



Place right leg between string and bow.



Now affix the two arrow rests.



Locate the large loop and slide it onto the top bow limb.



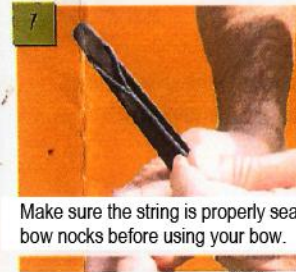
Lock lower bow limb with your left leg.



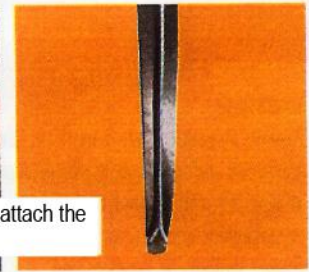
Bend the upper limb while dragging the string onto its nock.



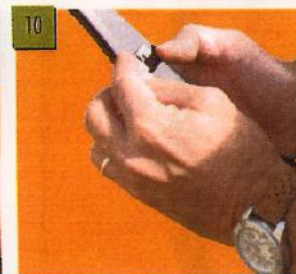
Give the cord a dozen twists and attach the small loop to the lower limb



Make sure the string is properly seated in the bow nocks before using your bow.



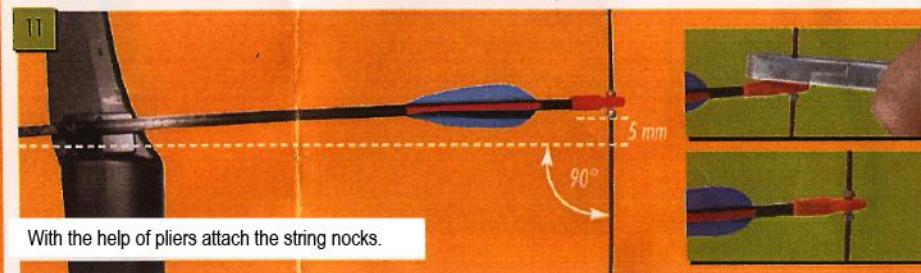

The right-handed rest is placed on the left, and the left-handed is placed on the right.



With the help of pliers attach the string nocks.



Install elastic onto the arm guard.
